NOT ALL CHANGE IS FOR THE BETTER AND THE BEST WAY TO ALLOW BAD CHANGE IS TO <u>IGNORE</u> IT AND THAT'S WHAT THE SILENT MAJORITY IS GUILTY OF. I'm reminded of Martin Niemoller's immortal anti-apathy quotation: First they came for the Socialists, and I did not speak out—Because I was not a Socialist. Then they came for the Trade Unionists, and I did not speak out—Because I was not a Trade Unionist. Then they came for the Jews, and I did not speak out—Because I was not a Jew.
